To what extent has the Vocabolario degli Accademici della Crusca spearheaded the making of the Italian language across the centuries, and to what extent did it contribute to 'create' the Italian language? Centennials are not only occasions for celebrations, they also invite to reflect on new re-

search findings and novel perspectives. The systematic comparison between the annotations and the critical remarks through time yields promising results for the history of the *Vocabolario* through its five editions.

Nicoletta Maraschio is professor at the University of Florence, where she teaches courses on the history of Italian Language. She is the President of the Accademia della Crusca and the president of CLIEO, Center of Historical and Theoretical Linguistics: Italian, European and Oriental Languages.
